

Egg-Lympics Rules & Setup

EGG TOSS: (3-6 yo) Place one (1) 5 gallon bucket 10 feet from a fixed line and give each child 10 plastic eggs. The one who makes the most in the bucket wins. Can set up in heats and have finals if more than 12 participants. The same holds true for the 7-10 year old division but the buckets will be placed 20 ft away from line.

RUBBER CHICKEN THROW: Mark a line and all contestants must remain behind the line and will have 2 opportunities to throw a rubber chicken. They may throw the chicken anyway they see fit as long as they don't cross the line. The participant who throws the furthest distance in feet wins.

5 EGG RELAY: Five (5) Cones will be set up 25 ft. apart for 3-6 group and 50 ft. for 7-10 year old group. A start line will be present. There will be an egg on top of all 5 cones. Contestant will have to run to cone secure egg between chin and chest and run back to start line where there will be a bucket. The catch is when every contestant returns they must swing arms and cluck like a chicken. The winner will be the contestant with the fastest time.

<u>OLD FASHIONED WHEEL BARROW RACE:</u> The contestants will have to race 100 ft. around a cone and back to the finish line. Done in teams of two and will be done by double elimination.

<u>WATER BALLOON TOSS:</u> Contestants will have to toss water balloons and try to get three of them in a bucket without them breaking. Their will be three buckets placed 15 ft from the contestant and he/she must get three (3) unbroken balloons in the same bucket. This is a timed event.

<u>WATERMELON ROLL:</u> The contestant must roll a watermelon on his or her hands and knees a distance of 150 feet and cross a finish line. The individual that crosses the finish line first will move on to the second round. The one individual left at the end of the competition will be declared the winner of the event. There should be no more than three people competing against one another in any given heat race.

GREAT AMERICAN SQUIRT GUN FIGHT: This will be a 15 minute timed event in which all contestants participating in the ball field must stay in play. All participants must use supplied squirt guns. The winners will be chosen from the contestants that are the driest at the end of the timed event.

EGG BALL ELIMINATION: There will be ten (10) soft balls placed in the middle of the ball field when the whistle blows contestants can grab the balls. It works on the same rules as dodge ball and you can be eliminated if the ball hits you below the neck or if a player catches the ball before it hits the ground. Anyone hit above the neck will be allowed to continue. If the same person throwing the ball hits someone more than once in the head they will be automatically disqualified. The last one left without being eliminated will be crowned the winner.
